Job Title: UTeach Dallas Ambassador

Dates Available: Summer 223 and Fall/Spring 2023-24 **Hours and Pay:** Up to 10 hours per week, \$15 per hour

Purpose: Ambassadors will share their experiences in the UTeach Dallas program with prospective UTeach students, including students in Step 1 and Step 2 courses, current UTDallas students, and the UTDallas community. Ambassadors will represent UTeach Dallas at outreach events and conferences. Training will be provided.

Essential Functions

- 1. Telling your "UTeach Dallas" story at summer orientations and other recruiting events.
- 2. Work with the UTeach Dallas staff and Advising to increase enrollment and retention in the UTeach Dallas program
- 3. Facilitate information sessions and other outreach events for prospective students
- 4. Facilitate retention events for current UTeach Dallas students
- 5. Work with the Education Technology Specialist/Program Coordinator to develop and manage PR/Recruitment: social media posts AND email campaigns graphic design & multimedia work
- 6. Design additional promotional materials
- 7. Represent UTeach Dallas at university wide events, including: Freshman and Transfer Orientation, Org Fairs, Scholars' Day, World Teachers' Day, Welcome Week, and more
- 8. Prepare reports and program summaries statistics on the effectiveness of the work
- 9. Assist in other UTeach Dallas events as assigned

Required Qualifications

- 1. Must have completed Step 1 and Step 2 (can be enrolled in S2 at time of application)
- 2. Must be planning to continue with the UTeach Dallas program
- 3. Must have an overall cumulative **GPA of 2.75 or above**.
- 4. Must Commit to work Summer 23 for multiple orientations and the following Fall/Spring 23-24
- 5. Must work a minimum of 15 hours of events/ service to the program per long semester
- 6. Ambassadors must attend their UTeach Dallas classes on any day for which they claim work hours. It is **NOT** acceptable to be too sick for class, but well enough to work on the same day.
- 7. Strong communication skills, event planning, social media (specifically Instagram content creation), and mentorship experience a plus.
